

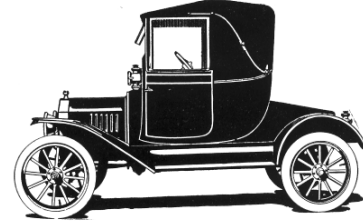

## **2007 Young Adult Education Class Schedule**

### **How Does That Engine Work???**

**What:** Join us for a **young adults' education class on the gasoline engine!** Students get to take apart a Briggs and Stratton one-cylinder engine and learn how solids, liquids, and gasses interact to make it run. Then we fire up a variety of engines to see how each gets their specific job done – from an antique Maytag washing machine to a 350-cubic inch V8 engine in the 1932 Little Deuce Coupe hotrod! If it's a good day, we might even get to fire up the Formula I race car! There is no driving or riding involved, and you won't get greasy. (Although we do promise lots of noise and smoke!)

**Who:** Middle School/Junior High: (5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> grade). **Students must be accompanied by an adult** – a great class for parents or grandparents to share with the young adults in their lives.

**Date and Time:** A one-day Saturday class at 9am. Class takes 2-3 hours, and well-illustrated hand-outs are provided. **Choose from one of the following dates: March 24, June 16, July 14, September 15, and October 20, 2007.**
